CLINICAL SERVICES

The mission of the Tele-Mental Health Service is to enhance care and community capacity in children's mental health using videoconferencing and other technologies to provide timely, equitable access to bilingual specialist services. Tele-Mental Health Service is committed to matching community needs with best evidence and excellence in care.

CLINICAL CONSULTATIONS

Over 40 child psychiatrists comprise the core clinical team offering a range of expertise and experience. Tele-Mental Health Service services may be accessed through multiple routes of referral: children's mental health agencies, community general hospitals, youth justice services, school boards, and community physicians. Models of service delivery are tailored to requested services.

PROGRAM CONSULTATIONS

In a program consultation, a consultant meets monthly with a designated group of mental health providers from a particular team (i.e. school-based day treatment programs, residential, family health team, etc.) to discuss clinical, program-wide, and community issues.

EDUCATION

Using videoconferencing and other technologies, Tele-Mental Health Service has developed a program of longitudinal, multi-part seminar series. These seminars cover a wide-range of clinical topics and are geared at either the introductory or advanced level to meet the needs of the diversity of practitioners.
